IMPORTANT ISSUE.**

Effective July 1, 2008, a grower may produce marijuana for no more than four (4) patients or designated primary caregivers concurrently (per ORS 475.320(2)(c) and OAR 333-008-0025(10)).

Although more than one grower may share a common grow site, it is important to note that **any garden containing over 99 plants could be at risk**, if prosecuted, of a **five year mandatory minimum prison sentence**, as per Federal Sentencing Guidelines.
